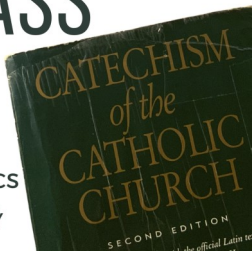

GREGORIAN CHANT GROUP

We are planning to start a **Gregorian Chant Group** to help to support the singing of the Gregorian Chant at the 12noon Solemn Mass on Sundays. One of our parishioners, Dr Rosemarie Darby, who teaches at the University of Manchester, will help with the establishing of this group and in teaching us the chant, supported by our organist, Nathan. Short practices will take place on Sunday mornings at 11am, in preparation for the 12noon with a view to beginning to lead the singing of the chant next Sunday, 8th October. PROCESSION TO RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION

I think it is time now for us to revert to the way we used to come forward to receive Holy Communion before the pandemic and so, from this Sunday, I suggest that in coming forward to receive Holy Communion, from wherever you are seated in the church, please approach the altar by the central aisle and return to your places by the side aisles, starting with those who are seated at the front of the church in the

central aisles, then row by row in the central aisles, then those in the side aisles. Please form two lines and then take it in turns to come forward to the priest at the altar steps.

RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION REVERENTLY

To receive Holy Communion reverently, we can either receive Holy Communion directly on the tongue or receive Holy Communion in the hand. If you choose to receive Holy Communion in the hand, please place one hand flat on top of the other hand and when the priest has placed the Sacred Host into the palm of one hand, please pick up the host with your other hand and consume the host in front of the priest. Please do not walk away to your place in church with the Sacred Host still in your hand. This is to ensure the reverent reception of Holy Communion.

- PARISH FUNDRAISING UPDATE -

SUCCESSFUL GRANT APPLICATIONS

We are pleased to say that we have been successful with four Grant Applications towards the costs of the **Phase One Works** on the church:

1. **National Churches Trust** has awarded a grant of **£30,000**
2. **The Wolfson Foundation** has awarded a grant of **£6,000**
3. **The Sir Harold Hood Charitable Trust** has awarded a grant of **£2,000**
4. **The Benefact Trust** has awarded a grant of **£6,725**

DONATIONS FROM PARISHIONERS

We are grateful for donations of **£2000** from parishioners received this week to help towards the fundraising for the costs of the roof. This brings individual donations to **£65,555** (of which £50,000 was a individual donation from a very generous parishioner)

The ongoing weekly generosity of parishioners to St Mary's is enabling us to undertake the Phase One Works immediately and have them finished by mid-summer, when we can begin to think about Phase Two of the restoration of St Mary's.
