You are invited to join us at St Mary's for a special time of prayer - Forty Hours of Adoration of Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament in the days leading up to the feast of Christ the King - Friday 24th November until Sunday 20th November. The 12 noon Solemn Sung Mass of the Feast of Christ the King will be followed by a short Blessed Sacrament Procession in church and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. The St Philip Neri Singers will lead the sacred music for the 12 noon Solemn Mass on the Feast of Christ the King to bring the time of Quarant'ore to a close.
